



Investing in UAE Markets through EIFB

Required Documentation

(Sole Partnership Companies - Establishment)

To invest in any of UAE markets, clients should have an investor number with DFM and/or ADSM. EIFB offers its clients the service of issuing the investor numbers on their behalf.

To ease the in and out flow of funds, EIFB opens for its clients a Stock Trading Account in Emirates Islamic Bank.

Then a Brokerage account will be opened with EIFB which will enable the client to trade in UAE Markets.

› For Issuing Investor Number (NIN) in DFM:

- Dully filled Investor Number Application.
- Letter with the Authorization Representatives (Addressed to DFM)
- Letter of undertaking by the investor stating that no investor number will be opened in his personal name. The proprietor (owner) of the institution must choose between obtaining an investor number in the name of his institution or in his personal name. The Market procedures prohibit having more than one investor number per person.

› For Issuing Investor Number (NIN) in ADSM:

- Dully filled Investor Number Application
- Letter with the Authorization Representatives (Addressed to ADSM)

› For Opening Stock Trading Bank Account:

- Dully filled Bank Account Application.

› For Opening Brokerage Account:

- Dully filled EIFB Brokerage Account Application.
- Letter with the Authorization Representatives (Addressed to EIFB)

› The applications needed for trading online:

- Online Trading Application.
- Bank Net Application (which will enable you to check on your bank account with EIB)

Along with the above signed applications, the following documents need to be attached:

- Copy of Khulasat Al Qaid.
- Copy of passport.
- Copy of commercial license.
- Copy of commercial registration.
